

MnSTARR 3.0 Help Guide

The Minnesota Screening Tool Assessing Recidivism Risk (MnSTARR) 3.0 is a validated assessment instrument that is designed to predict an individual's likelihood of felony and violent reoffending within three years of release from prison.

Who?

The MnSTARR 3.0 assesses the recidivism risk of adults and certified adults who have an active Minnesota commitment and are incarcerated at the time of the assessment.

Description of MnSTARR 3.0 Items

The items included in the MnSTARR 3.0 are dependent on the facility where the resident has been placed. If the custody responsibility is the Minnesota Correctional Facility (MCF)-Shakopee, the gender used will be female. If the custody responsibility is any other facility, the gender used will be male.

Assessment Scores

Felony Recidivism Score: The sum total of the item values for the Felony Recidivism scale.

Felony Recidivism Percentile Rank: This number represents a person's risk for a felony offense reconviction within three years of release from prison relative to everyone else in Minnesota's prison system. The percentile ranking ranges from 0 to 100%, with higher values reflecting a greater relative risk for felony recidivism.

Violent Recidivism Score: The sum total of the item values for the Violent Recidivism scale.

Violent Recidivism Percentile Rank: This number represents a person's risk for a violent offense reconviction within three years of release from prison relative to everyone else in Minnesota's prison system. The percentile ranking ranges from 0 to 100%, with higher values reflecting a greater relative risk for violent recidivism.

Repeat Sex Offense Recidivism: The value is set to the Predicted Probability of Sexual Recidivism from the Minnesota Sex Offense Screening Tool-4 (MnSOST-4) assessment for men and the Adult Dynamic Validated Instrument for Sex Offense Recidivism (ADVISOR) for women. Both the MnSOST-4 and the ADVISOR are manually scored by staff in the Risk Assessment Community Notification unit. If a MnSOST-4 score does not exist but a MnSOST-3.1 or MnSOST-3 does exist, the Sex Offense Recidivism Score will be set to those scores, respectively.
