Authorization for Juvenile Resident/Incarcerated Youth Health
Services

Juvenile residents/incarcerated youth housed in a DOC facility may be provided with timely access to medical, dental, mental or other health services by qualified persons as deemed necessary.

Beyond rendering basic first aid or emergency care, authorization by a parent or legal guardian is required for the DOC to provide health services to minors. A separate authorization is required: 1) for the initiation of neuroleptic medications after assessment (but not for tapering off) and 2) for non-emergency surgical procedures.
