<p>If victim has already changed clothes, determine location of clothing worn at the time of the incident. If clothing is not at crime scene, secure it in paper evidence bags one item per bag.</p> <p>If the victim has not changed clothing, they must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stand on a white sterile sheet or pad and remove all clothing items one at a time. • Carefully remove footwear and socks. • Place all clothing in a separate, sealed paper evidence bag. • Fold the white sterile sheet or pad inward and place it in a separate, sealed paper evidence bag. • Give the victim state-issued clothing and transport them to a healthcare facility or hospital. <p>Follow Policy 301.035, "Evidence Collection," for evidence management.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
